

YEAR 1 WORKSHOP

'Goldilocks and the 3 Bears'

30 minutes

Objective

To make the experience of hearing live classical music enjoyable for the children as well as teaching them more about string instruments through the story of Goldilocks and the 3 Bears.

By telling a variation on the story of *Goldilocks and the 3 Bear's* we can incorporate short sections of classical music, nursery rhymes and television tunes the children may recognise.

They will be able to interact by singing along with some of the songs, clapping and cheering for *Goldilocks* and booing the grumpy *Daddy Bear!*

Daddy, Mummy and *Baby* bear will be depicted by the 'cello, viola and violin(s) so the children will gain an understanding of size and pitch and how they are related. We will also touch on dynamics and tempo, as well as explaining briefly how a string instrument produces sound.

Pulse and rhythm will be introduced by encouraging the children to stamp with *Daddy Bear* and clap with *Baby Bear*.
